

HAMBURG TOWNSHIP GOLF CART RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the State of Michigan Vehicle Code, Act 300 of 1949 provides local municipalities with populations of less than 30,000 residents the power to authorize the use of golf carts on public streets; and

WHEREAS, the 2010 U.S. decennial census estimates that the population of Hamburg Township is 21,165; and

WHEREAS, local municipalities, through legislative resolution, have the option to adopt the regulations outlined in Section 257.657a of the Michigan Vehicle Code; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Hamburg Township is the legislative body to which the aforementioned resolution must be voted upon to allow residents the right to traverse public roads on a low-speed golf cart within Hamburg Township in accordance with the Michigan Vehicle Code, Act 300 of 1949, Section 257-657a; with the provision that said low-speed golf carts are not identified and listed within Hamburg Township Police Department; and

WHEREAS, there is one state trunk-line (M-36) in Hamburg Township to which its resolution does not apply, except in instances in which an individual golf cart operator may cross said state trunk-line; and

WHEREAS, "golf cart" means a vehicle designed for transportation while playing the game of golf, with the provision that said low-speed golf carts are not registered nor inspected by the Hamburg Township Police Department; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Board of Hamburg Township hereby adopts the applicable provisions, and in accordance with the Michigan Vehicle Code, Act 300 of 1949, Section 257.657a, thereby allowing all residents and businesses the right to use a low-speed golf cart to traverse the township on public roads.


